## **USHER NOTES**

- 1. Please check the enclosed schedule. If you cannot usher the month assigned, please call Bill Hoeft at 320-249-6581.
- 2. If you cannot usher on an assigned Sunday, please try to switch with someone on the schedule.
- 3. From September-May, please ask youth that are present at worship to help usher—youth & their parent can both be asked so they may work together as a team. If no youth are available, ask an adult to help. On Communion Sundays, only youth that are in, or have had confirmation can help with serving Communion.
- 4. Please be at your station at least **25 minutes prior to the service.**
- 5. First service ushers need to light candles and make sure the cross is on. Second service ushers will need to extinguish candles and turn cross light off.
- 6. Try to keep rear pews available for families with small children. You might offer a child's worship bag to young children. (They hang on a stand near the library.)
- 7. Ushers at East entrance are to count attendance and record on sheet in drawer of podium by stairs. Also, please be prepared to ring bell at appropriate time during service.
- 8. After each service, pick up bulletins, communion cups, and anything left in pews. Please check number of hymnals and bibles, **and straighten books in each pew rack.**
- 9. 2<sup>nd</sup> service ushers should also tear out sheets from registration pads. Refill with prayer cards, offering envelopes, and registration sheets if needed, and put at the left end of each pew. (New pads, cards, and envelopes are located in the usher cabinet near library.) Replace and sharpen pencils as needed.
